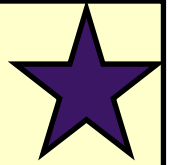
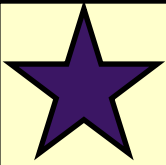
*“Caseloads in Barnet’s Family Services are amongst the lowest in London.”*

*“Agency staff usage is lower than for most local authorities in London”.*

Over half of all staff in Family Services report they do not have to work excessive hours to meet the requirements of the job and that they are able to strike the right balance between work and home life. Yet stress levels over the last 3 months have produced a significant increase in time off-sick for workers in Family Services and the staff turnover rate remains at 30% (compared to around half that rate for Adults and Communities).
