YOUR RIGHTS AT WORK

Members report they have been taken off their rounds for reasons such as:

- Not taking breaks
- They have missed collections
- They won't work overtime that day
- They are working too fast or too slow
- Driver won't leave the vehicle unattended
- Work not completed

However there are occasions when no reasons have been given. So far we have had some discussions with managers about workers being moved, but we have rarely mentioned the names of the workers as often workers don't want to take it that far. During the last four months there have been a lot of changes to the Waste and Recycling service.

Things have to change.

Barnet UNISON has asked to see the finishing times for April and May so that we can see evidence of what time rounds are finishing. In the meantime, Barnet UNISON is offering every UNISON member representation in a meeting if a worker is unhappy about being taken off their rounds.
