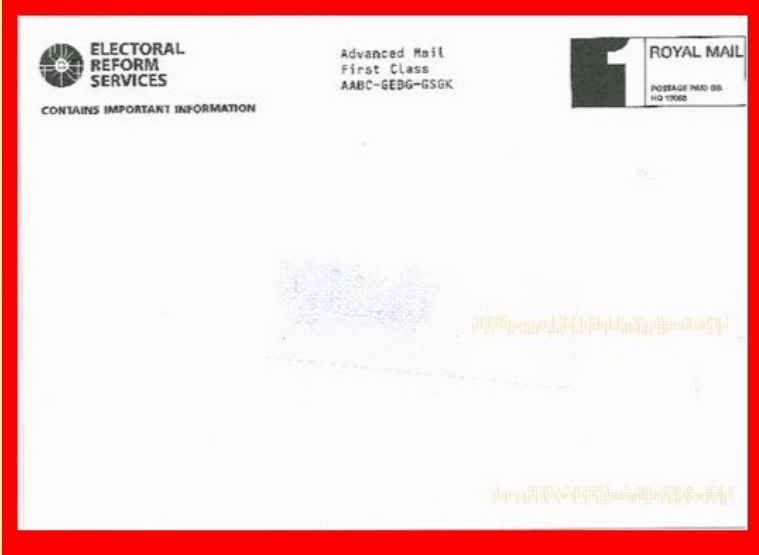

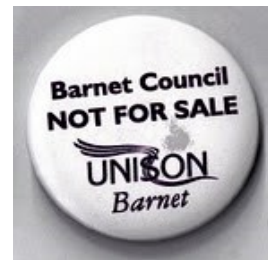

IMPORTANT UPDATE: Personal Information Questionnaire.

Dear Colleagues

A number of members are raising concerns about why the Council are asking staff to provide **Personal Information Questionnaire**.

The reason is directly linked to **Unified Pay**.

In negotiations the Trade Unions have been concerned about how the proposals may impact on the Council workforce. We have asked the Council to conduct what is known and an Equalities Impact Assessment of each of the Council s Unified Pay proposals in order to establish if any group of workers are particularly disadvantaged.

In order to provide this information the Council need to make sure their staffing data is accurate, which is why Barnet UNISON is asking members to provide their details.
