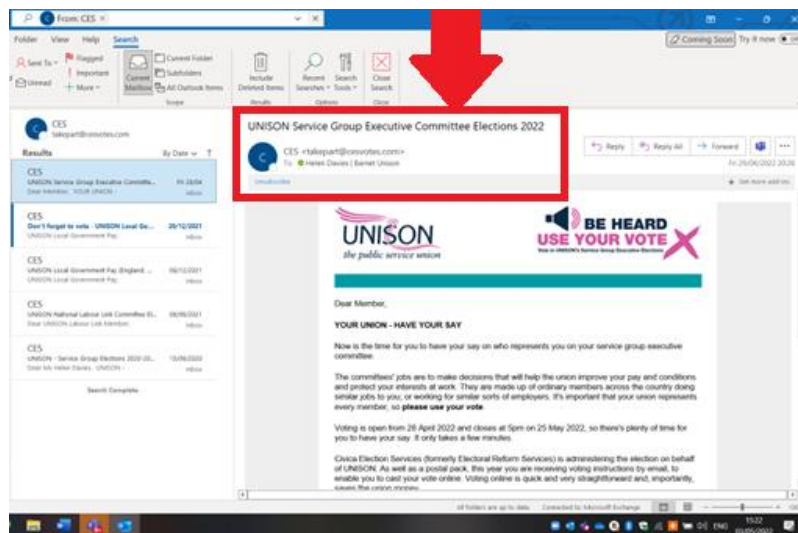


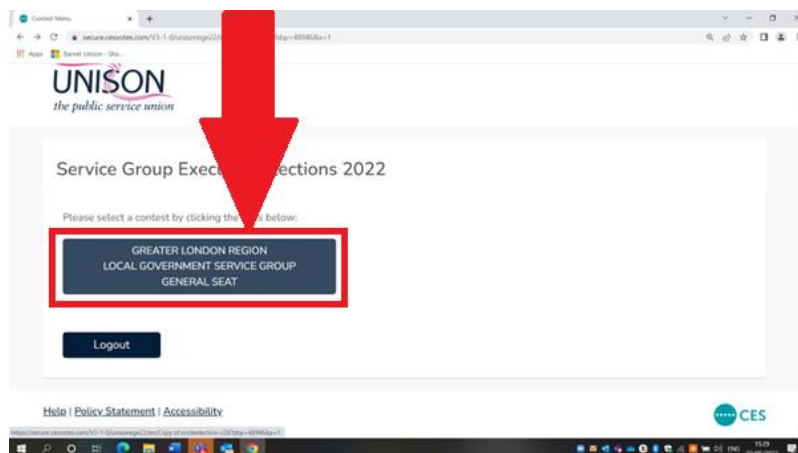
Have You Voted in the Service Group Elections?

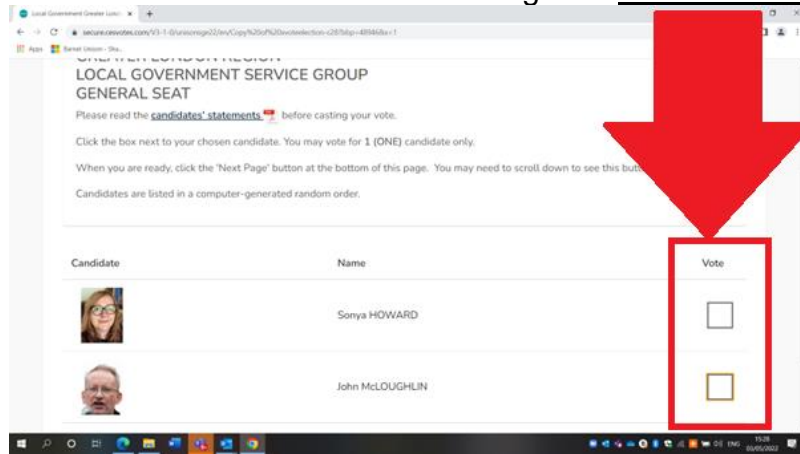
If you get emails from UNISON then you will have been sent a link to vote in the Service Group Elections. In the London area they seem to have been sent out last **Friday 29th April approximately 8.30pm**. It will have come from **CES** with a subject line **UNISON Service Group Executive Elections**.



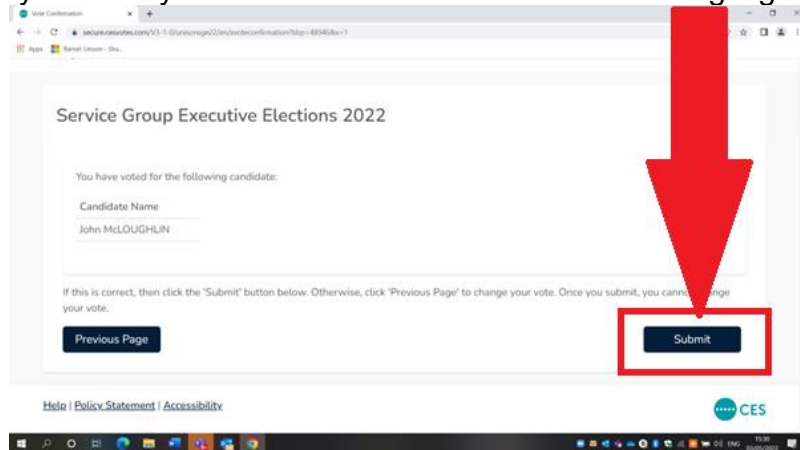
When you open it you will only have one choice to click on the square which says Greater London Region Local Government Service Group General Seat.



This opens up the ballot form. You can read the candidates' statements before voting. You have to choose between one of 2 people. **It's up to you how you vote.** Barnet UNISON nominated John McLoughlin - [Click here to read more](#)



The next screen will display the name of the candidate you have voted for, to complete your vote you must click the 'Submit' button as highlighted below.



You will also be sent a paper version of the ballot but only one of your voting methods will be counted.
