Barnet Council had the opportunity on 1 September 2023, to avert this strike but instead have taken an aggressive approach. Instead of taking up the offer to negotiate they have chosen confrontation. We have had a **further 4 social workers** leave the service since the strikes began at the end of September.

Today is the 21st Day of strike action. Our members are determined to continue to take strike action in support of their claim for Fair Pay, Safe Service, No Waiting Lists.

Anti -Union laws

Over the past 13 years the Government has tried to make it difficult for workers to take strike action. One of the changes is that a strike ballot result is only valid for 6 months. Our members have agreed that they want to continue to fight which means that they will be reballoted later this month in order they can continue with further strike action throughout 2024.
